Programs offered by River City	Curriculum Description
EDUCATION / GED	ABLE education Each resident's educational abilities and needs are assessed upon entry into the program. When educational needs are identified, residents work with an Education Specialist to improve skills and may work to increase skills and if possible earning a GED.
CAREY GUIDE	Structured tools and evidence based strategies helping individuals overcome barriers to change and reduce recidivism
MORAL REASONING	Increase their sense of responsibility to or concern for others.
ANGER MANAGEMENT	Anger Management (Texas Christian University curriculum) Anger management groups are provided for residents who have a history of aggressive behavior or demonstrate other indicators of difficulty regulating feelings of anger.
SUBSTANCE ABUSE	University of Cincinnati CBI program for Substance Abuse
THINKING FOR A CHANGE	CBI program from National Institute of Corrections Thinking for a Change is a group intervention that targets three main areas: (a) Cognitive Restructuring (b) Social Skills Training and (c) Problem Solving Skills. All RCCC residents must successfully complete this curriculum
TRAUMA INFORMED CARE	Trauma-informed care shifts the focus from <i>"What's wrong with you?"</i> to <i>"What happened to you?"</i> A trauma-informed approach to care acknowledges that organizations need to have a complete picture of the residents life situation — past and present — in order to provide effective services. Adopting trauma-informed practices can potentially improve engagement, treatment adherence, and health outcomes. Residents understand their past does not predict thier future.
TRAUMA INFORMED CARE Weapons Class	Trauma-informed care focused on why you feel the need to have a weapon, what cirumstances need to change to avoid carrying a weapon and understanding the cause and possible effects of having a weapon.
THINKING ERRORS	Group sessions designed to challenge the reframe thinking patterns.
PARENTING	Parenting (Texas Christian University curriculum) Programming in the area of parenting is another treatment option for residents who have not developed adequate parenting skills.
GREIF	Grief support group for the residents
FATHERHOOD	Fatherhood Nurturing Father's classes. Residents discuss the role of a nurturing father and what it means to them. Partnership with Talbert House
AA/NA	Alcohol and narcotic group therapy
JOB READINESS	University of Cincinnati CBI program for job readiness
SEX OFFENDER	University of Cincinnati SO CBI curriculum for Sex Offender treatment.
RECOGNIZING RESPONSIBLE BEHAVIOR	Cognitive-behavioral Curriculum examine past behaviors tht led to criminal involvement in the justice system and learn alternative ways of thinking.
RELAPSE PREVENTION	University of Cincinnati CBI program for Substance Abuse Success Planning
VOCATIOINAL WELDIIING	Partnershp with ELITE welding Acadamey for 6 week 240 hour welding training program
VOCATIONAL LIFT	Logistics, Inventory Management, Facilities Management and Transportation (LIFT) offers an opportunity for unemployed and underemployed adults. This 10-week free job training program will supply hands-on training from experienced warehouse personnel at Freestore Foodbank, specialized coursework designed by Gateway Community and Technical College, as well as links to local employment through other program partners.
